PUZZLE OF THE WEEK



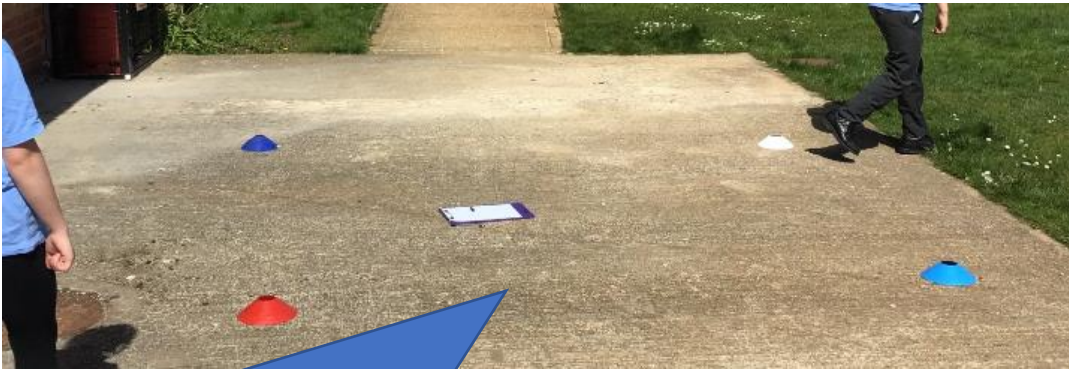
Word Wheel – Find as many words as possible using the letters in the wheel.

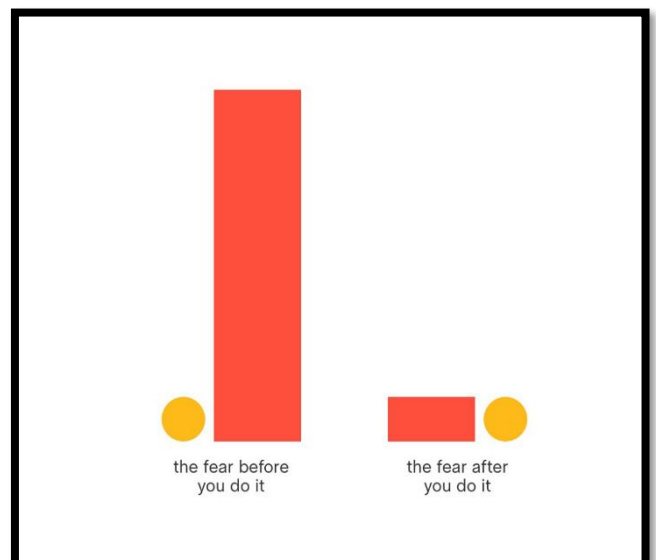
