Wimbledon: A British Sporting Tradition

Wimbledon begins today on **29th June** and is one of the most famous sporting events in the world. Held in London at the All England Lawn Tennis and Croquet Club, Wimbledon is the oldest tennis tournament and was first played in **1877**. It is also the only Grand Slam tournament still played on **grass courts**, making it unique in professional tennis.

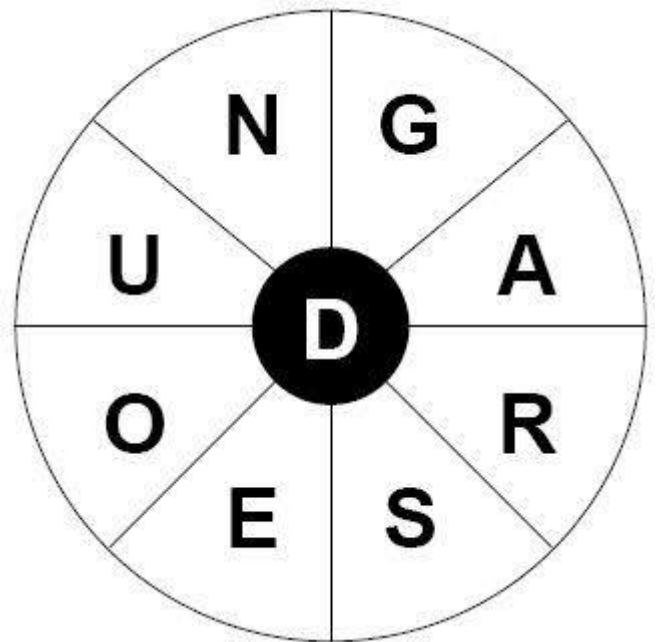
Over the years, Wimbledon has become known for its traditions, including players wearing mostly white clothing and the excitement of matches on Centre Court. Some of the most famous champions include Roger Federer, who won eight men's singles titles, Serena Williams with seven singles titles, and Novak Djokovic, one of the most successful modern players.

There are also some surprising facts about Wimbledon. Around **54,000 tennis balls** are used during the tournament, and a trained hawk called **Rufus** helps keep pigeons away from the courts! Wimbledon continues to bring together the world's best players every summer.
